Water Rate Increase

The district strives to meet the growing demand of our customers in conjunction with maintaining and improving the existing investment in our infrastructure. At the districts November 19, 2009 meeting, the Board of Directors adopted new water rates, which will become effective for water consumption during the month of January 2010 (to be reflected in the February 2010 billing statements). The new rates are attributable to new water system improvement projects. The water system improvements include construction of new water transmission lines and renovations of the district's water treatment plant.

A summary of the rate changes approved by the Board of Directors is set forth below.
